OVERVIEW

Systems Thinking allows for improvement at the departmental, team or business unit level by focusing on understanding and anticipating the potential consequences of all actions. This workshop explores how participants can overcome sub-optimisation of performance that is created by the misalignment of operating models (Systems) that inhibits efficiency and continuous improvement. It provides the basis for leadership development through clarity of accountability, dialogue with stakeholders and establishment of measures of performance.

Thrive35 uses action-learning training techniques to guide participants to learn about Systems Thinking and to apply the learnings into the context of their own organisation. The workshop is designed for managers and team leaders of an organisation who have the key responsibility of operational leadership and decision-making.

During this course, participants will learn to align their organisational system. Participants will be provided the Systems Thinking workbook that can be used to apply the learning gained during this course and improve their organisations.
