The workshop is designed for managers and team leaders of an organisation who have the key responsibility of operational leadership and decision-making.

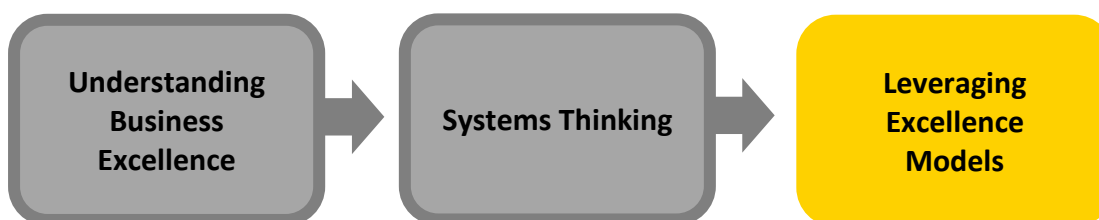
